- The cast of characters
 - 1. The stars Jesus and Mary
 - 2. The other roles shepherds, angels, wise men, Herod
 - 3. Best character in a supporting role Joseph
- The man God chose
 - 1. A high-value man in God's sight
 - 2. A man who would be considered worthy to raise Jesus
 - 3. A man God could trust

WHAT GOD SAW IN JOSEPH (Matthew 1:18-25 NASB)

- A godly example a righteous, upright man
 - 1. His response to Mary's apparent betrayal
 - 2. Even though he was hurt, he did not want to hurt Mary
- A heart to believe God
 - 1. He did not push back on the angel's message
 - 2. The word from the angel was all he needed to go on
- · A willingness to take on a bigger purpose
 - 1. A purpose bigger than him raising a Savior for the people
 - 2. A purpose that superseded his plans
 - 3. He called the baby what God called Him

LEARNING FROM JOSEPH - (WALKING WORTHY)

- The strength to be a good example
 - 1. Treating people with grace and kindness
 - 2. It takes strength to not fire back
 - 3. Paul's prayer for the church was to be strengthened
- · A heart inclined to believe God
 - 1. We believe God's Word is God speaking to us today
 - 2. When we are willing to believe we don't live dominated by what we see and feel
 - 3. Believing God's Word and what He speaks to our hearts by the Holy Spirit
- The willingness to become a part of a bigger purpose
 - 1. A purpose bigger than just what touches our life
 - 2. As believers in Christ, we have a higher purpose (Philippians 2:14-15 NLT)
