PART 8: IMMERSED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

THE EXPERIENCE OF PENTECOST WAS NOT A ONE-OFF EVENT

- Philip at Samaria (Acts 8:4-8, 12-13 NKJ)
 - 1. He preached Christ to them
 - 2. Miracles were taking place and there was great joy in the city
 - 3. Men and women were baptized including a former witchdoctor, Simon
- But wait there's more (Acts 8:14-20 NKJ)
 - 1. Salvation had come to Samaria they had received the Word of God
 - Peter and John prayed for them to receive the Holy Spirit
 - 3. Something happened when Peter and John laid hands on them

MORE HOLY SPIRIT OUTPOURINGS

- On the Gentiles (surprise surprise) (Acts 10:38-40, 43 NKJ)
 - 1. Peter proclaimed Jesus to Gentiles
 - 2. The Holy Spirit poured out (Acts 10:44-47 NKJ)
- On new believers in Ephesus (Acts 19:1-6 NKJ)
 - 1. If they received everything at the new birth
 - 2. These disciples of John the Baptist had yet to receive Jesus
 - 3. And then Paul laid hands on them

WHY THE CONTROVERSY?

- Reasons the Baptism in the Holy Spirit has sparked division
 - 1. The enemy think Satan wants empowered believers?
 - 2. Passed away theology (1 Corinthians 13:8 NKJ)
 - 3. Fear (1 Corinthians 14:32-33 NKJ)

A LESSON FROM THE OLD TESTAMENT

- Two tribes did not want to enter the Promised Land (Numbers 32:2, 4-7 NKJ)
 - 1. They chose land on the east side of the Jordan
 - They were satisfied to not go into the land God had promised
- Moses wasn't having it
 - 1. Why will you discourage the hearts of Israel
- A compromise was reached (Numbers 32:16-18 NKJ)
 - 1. The two tribes would help Israel possess what belonged to them from the Lord
- The main lesson is do not discourage your brothers and sisters in Christ
 - 1. If you are content with where you are in the Lord fine
 - 2. But don't discourage others from receiving what God has provided for them
