✓ Should be a contrast between the tents of the righteous and those without God

# Some Of The Voices In Our Tents

- A. Recap
  - 1. Silence better than negatives but may indicate another challenge
  - 2. Sighing / Groaning giving voice to sorrow or despair
  - 3. Complaining not to be in our tent because we are lights in a dark world
- B. Cursing (James 3:8-11 NKJV)
  - 1. To wish harm or evoke evil upon
  - 2. Does not mean we avoid honesty (2 Timothy 3:1-5 NKJV)
- C. What comes out of us helps define us (Romans 3:12-14 NKJV)
  - 1. This passage describes the condition of fallen man
  - 2. God places an emphasis on what comes out of us

# AS NEW CREATIONS WE ARE TO HAVE A NEW VOICE (Ephesians 4:21-24 NKJV)

- A. We are not who we used to be, spiritually speaking
  - 1. We did not "get religion" we were changed
  - 2. But we have to be intentional about the transition from old to new
- B. We adopt a new perspective
  - 1. Renewal of the mind
- C. Now we began to "walk out" what has been worked in us (Ephesians 4:25-32 NKJV)
  - 1. A function of renewal and putting on the new man change in actions
- D. The "new man" has a "new voice"
  - 1. Not lying but speaking truth (Ephesians 4:15 NKJV)
  - 2. No corrupt (toxic) words
  - 3. No clamor loud quarreling (James 3:17 NKJV)
  - 4. Evil speaking verbal abuse against someone
