- B. When it comes to you, what is the first thing
 - 1. The first thing that comes to your mind?
 - 2. What is the first thing out of your mouth? (Luke 6:45 NKJ)
 - 3. What is in our mind and heart is our vision of ourselves
- C. Changing the treasure of our heart (what is in us)
 - 1. Focusing on our weak areas will not make us stronger (Romans 8:6 NKJ)
 - 2. Acknowledge what has been done in us in Christ (Philemon 6 NKJ)
 - 3. Acknowledge God's presence and help (Hebrews 13:5-6 NKJ) (Romans 1:16-17 NKJ)
 - 4. Repeat the above (Proverbs 4:20-22 NKJ)

 - 2. Acknowledge your strengths in Christ
 - 3. Take steps in the right direction
