THE HANDS TELL A STORY

- · Hand signs in sports
 - 1. Hands on the head what just happened?
 - 2. Hands on hips tired
 - 3. Hands raised over the head touchdown / sign of victory
- Our hands toward God
 - 1. Our hands lifted up indicates a place of strength (Hebrews 12:12a KJV)
 - 2. The author was quoting (Isaiah 35:3-4 NKJV)

WHEN HANDS WERE LIFTED (Exodus 17:8-15 NKJV)

- · Israel was attacked and forced to fight
 - 1. But Moses told Joshua he was not alone in this battle
- Moses kept his hands lifted holding the rod of God
 - 1. The rod of God represented God's power and authority
 - 2. When God's power and authority were exalted Israel won
- Moses' hands became tired so he utilized help
 - 1. Moses had two men hold up his hands
 - 2. Moses did not try to go it alone not a time for pride
- After the victory Moses built an altar so he and Israel could remember what God had done
 - 1. Jehovah-Nissi the Lord my banner or standard

LIFT UP OUR HANDS

- We didn't start this battle, we were attacked
 - 1. But we are going to have to fight
- · It is vital that we keep our hands lifted up
 - 1. Acknowledging the power and authority of God
 - 2. We lift our hands in praise to the One who helps us and turns the battle for us (Matthew 21:16) & (Psalm 8:2 NKJV)
- Don't try this alone we all need help holding up our hands
 - 1. Good to have people in your life that can help you part of this church's role
 - 2. Good to have the Holy Spirit to help us (Ephesians 3:16 NKJV)
- God is our victory flag (Zephaniah 3:16-17 NKJV)
 - 1. We can lift our hands because we have another source of help and strength
