THINGS THAT WEAR US DOWN

- · Three barriers to enjoying life
 - 1. Fears
 - 2. Resentment
 - 3. Guilt / Regrets
- · But there is help with God
 - 1. Fear does not have to dominate
 - 2. Resentment can be eliminated
 - 3. There is forgiveness for our sins and mistakes (Psalm 130:3-4 NKJV)

A TALE OF TWO MEN

- Judas *(Matthew 27:3-5 NKJV)*
 - 1. He never thought things would get this bad
 - 2. He felt bad about what he had done
 - 3. He tried to make things right but with the wrong people
 - 4. He came to the wrong conclusion
- Peter *(Matthew 26:69-75 NKJV)*
 - 1. Peter abandoned Jesus at a very vulnerable time
 - 2. He knew he had done wrong
- Two men who did wrong, but one gave himself a chance at forgiveness (Mark 16:6-7 NKJV)
 - 1. Peter most likely disqualified himself from being a disciple
 - 2. But God gave him another chance tell the disciples and Peter

THE DIFFERENCE; WE ARE FORGIVEN, PEOPLE WITH ANOTHER CHANCE

- Don't Overestimate Your Errors and Underestimate God's Mercy (Lamentations 3:21-23 NKJV)
 - 1. Swap the perspective
 - 2. Recall to mind His mercy and compassion
- Receive God's forgiveness (1 John 1:9 NKJV)
 - 1. When we acknowledge/confess before Him is when we are forgiven
 - 2. Accept God's forgiveness by faith; don't wait for a feeling
 - 3. Forgive yourself we don't pay for our sins with God Jesus already did that
- Extend forgiveness to others (Ephesians 4:32 NKJV)
 - 1. We are forgiven people, so we pass it on
 - 2. If they ask for forgiveness and if they don't ask for forgiveness
 - 3. There is a difference between giving forgiveness and earning trust
