WHEN THERE IS CARE

- · Care: To be concerned and interested in
 - 1. There is confidence in the relationship
 - 2. There is more of a tendency to believe the best
 - 3. There can still be problems but they are worked through
- · When you have a God who cares
 - 1. We can not determine God's care looking at the problems
 - 2. Believing in a caring God is a faith position (1 Peter 5:7 NKJ)

THE CARE OF JESUS (Mark 6:34-44 NKJ)

- · He cared about spiritual and natural needs
 - 1. He had compassion and taught them
 - 2. He did not want them to walk home hungry so He fed them
- · He asked the disciples for what they had
 - 1. This was not beyond their ability
 - 2. They had to turn loose of what they had
- · He provided more than enough
 - 1. People ate until they were filled
 - 2. Still an abundance left over

WITH A GOD WHO CARES FOR YOU

- He will help with spiritual and material needs (Philippians 4:19 NKJ)
 - 1. Not just interested in your church life
 - 2. Recognize that teaching is caring Jesus fed spiritually first
- · He will work with what you give Him
 - 1. It's a trust thing (Galatians 5:7 NKJ)
 - 2. What we hold onto is not enough
- God cares enough to...
 - 1. Help you barely get by?
 - 2. Give you enough to fill you?
 - 3. Supply enough for you and for plenty left over? (Ephesians 3:20 NKJ)
