THREE BAPTISMS

- Baptized into the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:13 NKJ)
 - 1. Done by the Holy Spirit when you received Jesus
- Baptism in water (Matthew 28:19 NKJ)
 - 1. Done by people
- Baptized with/in the Holy Spirit (Mark 1:7-8 NKJ)
 - 1. This baptism is referenced in all 4 gospels
 - 2. Jesus is doing the baptizing
 - 3. Immersed with/in the Holy Spirit

JESUS' LAST INSTRUCTIONS

- An expansion of His last instructions (Acts 1:4-8 NKJ)
 - 1. He commanded them to wait for the Promise of the Father
 - 2. The comparison between water baptism and Holy Spirit baptism
 - 3. You shall receive power the power was to be a witness of Jesus

PENTECOST

- A Jewish feast day
 - 1. 50 days after Passover Jews from all over the world in Jerusalem at this time
- The initial outpouring of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-4 NKJ)
 - 1. Not just for the 11 apostles 120 were in that room
- The followers came out of the upper room into the streets
 - 1. Peter preaches a message (Acts 2:17-18 NKJ) (Acts 2:32-33 NKJ)
 - 2. The Holy Spirit does His work of convincing of sin (Acts 2:36-39 NKJ)
 - 3. Peter's instructions
- This was the day everything changed for the disciples
 - 1. Now they understood scriptures connecting Old Testament prophecies with Jesus
 - 2. They went from hiding in an upper room to out in the street
 - 3. Peter went from being intimidated by a servant girl to preaching boldly
 - 4. The disciples experienced beatings, prison and threats, but would not stop

THE EXPERIENCE OF PENTECOST WAS NOT A ONE-OFF EVENT

- Philip at Samaria (Acts 8:4-8, 12-13 NKJ)
 - 1. He preached Christ to them
 - 2. Miracles were taking place and there was great joy in the city
 - 3. Men and women were baptized
- But wait there's more (Acts 8:14-20 NKJ)
 - 1. Salvation had come to Samaria they had received the word of God
 - 2. Peter and John prayed for them to receive the Holy Spirit
 - 3. Something happened when Peter and John laid hands on them
