- A. When they work . . .
  - 1. A great source of happiness
  - 2. They add to life
- B. When they don't work . . .
  - 1. One of the greatest sources of pain
- C. All relationships can benefit from a refresh (Hebrews 2:1 NIV)
  - 1. Employer / employee
  - 2. Spouse / family
  - 3. Friendships
  - 4. Even our relationship with God

# **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THOSE WHO WOULD BECOME KINGS**

#### (Deuteronomy 17:16-20 NKJV)

- A. Kings needed to stay right
  - 1. They were responsible to God and to the people they served
- B. Don't pursue the wrong things
  - 1. Horses represented possessions
  - 2. Wives represented passion
  - 3. Greatly multiply silver and gold represented power
  - 4. A key phrase that is repeated is "for himself"
- C. A daily plan with a definitive outcome
  - 1. To have and read a copy of God's word all the days of his life (constant refresh)
  - 2. The end result is that he and his family would be blessed

# REFRESHING YOUR RELATIONSHIPS

- A. To refresh refocus
  - 1. Where we focus is often the indicator of what we treasure (Luke 12:34 NKJV)
  - 2. Reallocate your time and attention a step in stopping drift
- B. To refresh remind (2 Peter 1:12-13 NKJV)
  - 1. Reminding stirs us up we may have gotten stale
  - 2. Reminding keeps us from taking people for granted
  - 3. Another way to stop drift
- C. To refresh with God take His instructions to kings to heart
  - 1. Don't spend all your time and energy pursuing the things of this life
  - 2. Have a daily time with God and His word
  - 3. Blessings associated with a refreshed walk (life) with God (Proverbs 8:34-35 NIV)
