Text: Romans 1:16-17 NKJ

So How Do You GET RIGHT WITH GOD?

- Conventional thinking
 - 1. Going to church
 - 2. Being good/not hurting people
 - 3. Obeying the 10 commandments
- · God's thoughts
 - 1. Not being good what is the standard for good
 - 2. Not by going to church church is to reach/equip and support
 - 3. Not by obeying the 10 commandments good, but not good enough
- The word is righteousness
 - 1. Simply put; being right in God's sight by His standards, not mans
 - 2. Available only through faith in Jesus (Acts 13:38-39 NLT)
 - 3. Grace is what made righteousness available to us (Galatians 2:21 NLT)

A PICTURE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS BY GRACE (2 Samuel 9:1-5 NKJ)

- The kindness of God
 - 1. David wanted to show kindness for Jonathan's sake
 - 2. Mephibosheth did not earn David's kindness
 - 3. David went and got him Meph did not come to David on his own
- A tainted perspective (2 Samuel 9:6-8 NKJ)
 - 1. David was blamed for Meph's disability
 - 2. Grew up with a tainted perspective of David
 - 3. Meph had a low view of himself referring to himself as a dead dog
- A restoration to rightstanding
 - 1. Mephibosheth was royalty, a king's grandson
 - 2. David restored his lands and servants
 - 3. He gave Meph a place of honor at his table

OUR PICTURE OF GOD'S LOVE TOWARD US

- · Because of His love and what Jesus did
 - 1. We did not earn anything
 - 2. We did not have anything we could offer God (Romans 5:10 NKJ)
 - 3. God came to us He sent Jesus
- Our tainted perspective
 - 1. We have often believed God was our problem
 - 2. We have not seen ourselves as He sees us
- Our being given a place of rightstanding with God (Colossians 1:12-14 NKJ)
 - 1. We have an inheritance in Christ
 - 2. We have been delivered from Satan's authority
 - 3. Our sins have been forgiven so we can stand righteous before Him
