BELIEVING DIFFERENTLY

WHAT WILL THIS YEAR HOLD?

- What do you believe?
 - 1. No idea we'll see
 - 2. Fearful low level sense of dread
 - 3. Looking for and expecting good things
- Believing for a good year (Psalm 27:13 NKJV)
 - 1. Not everything was perfect could have lost heart (courage)
 - 2. But believed to see the goodness of the Lord before it got good

TWO WHO BELIEVED DIFFERENTLY

- 12 spies sent to look at the land (Numbers 13:27-28, 30-31 NKJV)
 - 1. God promised them this land a good land
 - 2. They all observed the same land but...
- Two totally different beliefs
 - 1. Two men said we can do this we are well able
 - 2. Ten men said we can't do this the people are stronger than we are
 - 3. The nation went with the majority expecting something bad
- Two men chose to believe something different about God (Numbers 14:7-9 NKJV)
 - 1. The Lord delights in us God's favor is on us
 - 2. The Lord will help us
 - 3. With the Lord's help we are stronger we don't have to be afraid

BELIEVING DIFFERENTLY THIS YEAR

- We can or we can't we choose
 - 1. We can't control everything that happens this year
 - 2. We can choose what we believe (Mark 5:36 NKJV)
- Do what makes you stronger in your heart (Joshua 14:7-8 NKJV)
 - 1. Hearing, thinking about and speaking negatives will not help you
 - 2. Hearing, thinking about God's word puts His words in your heart
 - 3. Speaking God's words, not what you feel and see, makes your heart stronger
- Choose to believe good things about God and you (Romans 8:31-32 NKJV)
 - 1. He delights/favors you
 - 2. That He will help you
 - 3. With His help you are stronger than what you will face this year
